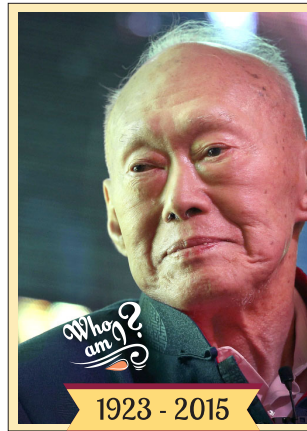
The past is past! To see real heroes, look around you.

He was named by Time magazine as one of the 100 most influential people of the 20th century.

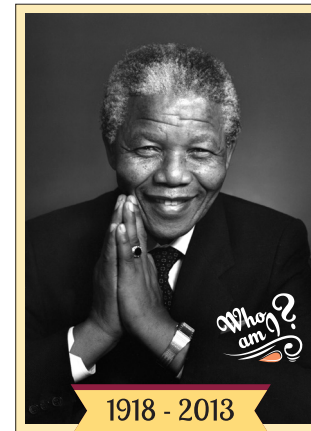

He graduated from Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge University, with double-starred first-class honours in law. He was the first Prime Minister of Singapore, governing for three decades. With his clear vision, he planned and led the country with deep conviction. He is recognised as the nation's founding father, with the country described as transitioning from the "third world to first world in a single generation" under his leadership.

On 23 March, 2015, 1.7 million residents and guests paid their last respect to him at his lying-in-state at Parliament House and at community tribute sites around the island.

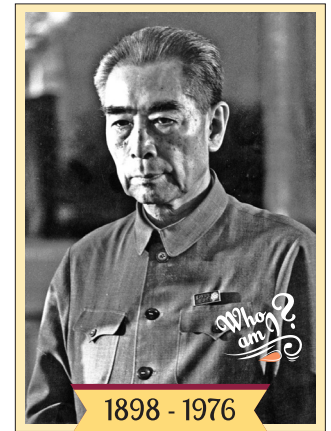

He is a great believer in education as it is part of the key to winning the struggle against apartheid. He was a non-violent anti-apartheid activist, politician and philanthropist who became South Africa's first black president from 1994 to 1999. He was actively involved in the anti-apartheid movement and joined the African National Congress in 1942. For 20 years, he directed a campaign of peaceful, non-violent defiance against the South African government and its racist policies. Beginning from 1962, Mandela spent 27 years in prison for political offenses.

Widely regarded as an icon of democracy and social justice, he received more than 250 honours, including the Nobel Peace Prize and is described as the "Father of the Nation."

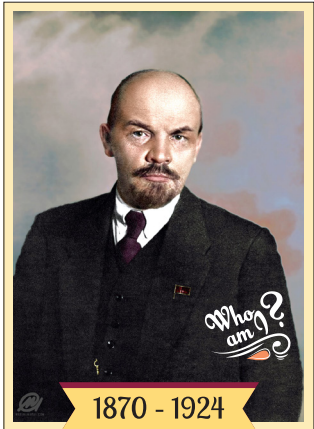
Everyone has to have a great aspiration to become a hero! Everyone has to be a person who opens a new era.

He was a Russian communist revolutionary, politician and political theorist. He served as head of government of Soviet Russia and of the Soviet Union. He was the founder of the Russian Communist Party, leader of the Bolshevik Revolution and architect and first head of the Soviet state. He was the posthumous source of "Leninism," a doctrine codified and conjoined with Marx's works by Lenin's successors to form Marxism-Leninism, which became the Communist worldview.

Lenin been regarded as the greatest revolutionary leader and thinker since Marx.

He is one of the most important figures of the 20th century in terms of art and art movements that occurred during this period. No other artists prior to Picasso had such an impact on the art world, or garnered a mass following of fans and critics alike, as he did.

He is one of the founding fathers of the People's Republic of China. At young age, he work and study abroad in Europe. After returning to China, he devoted himself to the revolutionary struggle for the independence and liberation of his people. His advocated policies of Chinese economic reform and "one country, two systems" had changed China in the late 20th century as well as influenced the world. He was the Time's Person of the Year, in 1978 and 1985.

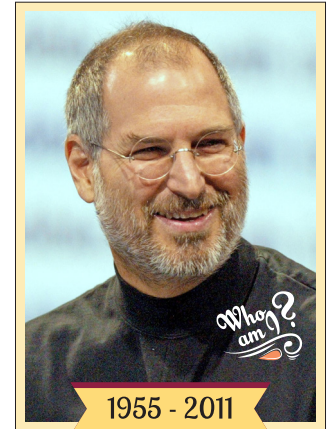

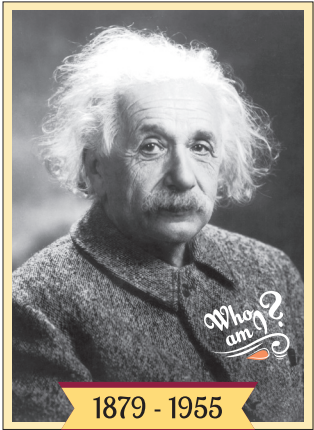

He is a German-born mathematician and physicist who developed the special and general theories of relativity, believed that real failure was in not starting or completing a task. In 1921, he won the Nobel Prize for physics for his explanation on the photoelectric effect. In the following decade, he immigrated to the U.S. after being targeted by the Nazis. His work also had a major impact on the development of atomic energy. In his later years, Einstein focused on unified field theory.

With his passion for making enquiry, Einstein is generally considered the most influential physicist of the 20th century.

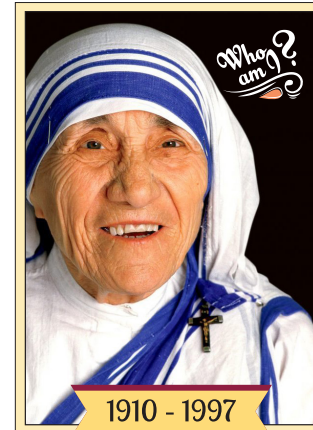

He was a British scientist, professor and author who performed ground-breaking work in physics and cosmology. He was the first to set out a theory of cosmology explained by a union of the general theory of relativity and quantum mechanics. At the age of 21, he was diagnosed with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) that gradually paralysed him. After losing his speech, he was still able to communicate through a speech-generating device, a hand-held switch, and a single cheek muscle.

Hawking was a fellow of the Royal Society (FRS), life-time member of the Pontifical Academy of Sciences, and a recipient of the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the highest civilian award in the United States.

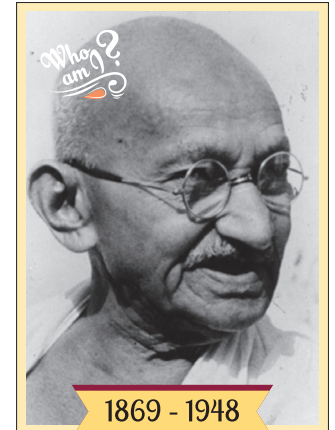

Born in Macedonia to parents of Albanian-descent, she lived in India most of her life, devoting her life to caring for the sick and poor, visiting them as well as providing them adequate health and medical care. She was the founder of the Order of the Missionaries of Charity, a Roman Catholic congregation of women dedicated to helping the poor.

Considered one of the 20th Century's greatest humanitarian, Mother Teresa received the Noble Peace Prize in 1979 and canonized as Saint Teresa of Calcutta in 2016.

He studied law and organised boycotts against British institutions in peaceful forms of civil disobedience. He was the primary leader of India's independence movement and also the architect of a form of non-violent civil disobedience that would influence the world. Employing non-violent civil disobedience, Gandhi led India to independence and inspired movements for civil rights and freedom across the world.

Gandhi devoted himself to the truth, fought against the discrimination and spoke out for peace and forgiveness.
